## Why the Congo?

In the Democratic Republic of the Congo:

Life expectancy in the Congo-DRC is 55 years ( Canada 72 years), access to sanitation is 79% ( Canada 100%), Female literacy 55 % ( Canada 100%), Primary school girls out of school 53% ( Canada 0%), literacy rates females 15-24 years 63% ( Canada 100%)

Together we can make a difference in the Congo.

In the Congo-DRC primary, secondary and university schools are not free. Parents have to pay tuition and other school related fees. They have to buy uniforms and all the necessities of the student.

## Objectives

- **EDUCATION:** To improve access to education by offering scholarships, sponsorships and grants to underprivileged students., by building community schools in communities in need, by providing special education to the analphabet, by building community libraries , by promoting re-search.

-**HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT:** To promote access to better sanitary conditions by building community clinics in communities in need, , by promoting health, by promoting maternal and child health, by building wells to improve access to clean water, , by planting trees in the city of Goma to improve better environment;

- **COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT:** To relieve poverty by establishing a centre for assisting orphans, streets kids and pregnant woman and other vulnerable people with food, clothes, and other basic necessities, to raise awareness in Canada of the plight faced by the vulnerable people (women and children) in the Congo, to provide assistance and relief to victims of war, volcanic eruption, food and other natural disaster, , to promote chicken, goats, pigs breeding, to instill the spirit of helpfulness to the young people.
